



Funky Frog Wave

Play this fun game with your kids and then sit down to talk about how it connects with Scripture.

Play:

The leader will explain that the audience is about to do the “wave” with a twist. Participants must squat like a frog and jump as high as they can when the leader passes their section. The leader must run past each section of the audience multiple times to allow participants the chance to complete the Funky Frog Wave. If time permits, change the leader and the animal action.

Connect:

In the Bible, the Hebrews were slaves to the Egyptians, but God told His prophet Moses that He was going to free them. God used frogs to help make that happen. Read and discuss the plague of frogs in Exodus 8:1-15. Explain to kids that each plague represented a god the Egyptians worshiped. Read Exodus 9:14. Explain that God sent the plagues to show the Egyptians and the Israelites that there is no other God besides Him. God is the one true God. He alone deserves our worship and praise.
