7. Was there ever a time you had questions about God or faith?
8. What helped you trust God during that time?
9. What do you do when you don't understand something about the Bible?

SECTION 4: PASSING FAITH TO THE NEXT GENERATION

10. What is one thing you hope I remember about God as I grow up?
11. How can we talk about Jesus more as a family?
12. How can I pray for you this week?
