Each card contains four simple prompts:

- 2. Intro Question**
- 3. Bible Application**
- 4. Leader Thought**



THEME:

MADE NEW

Verse:

"Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has passed away, and see, the new has come!"

— 2 Corinthians 5:17 (CSB)



MADE NEW

1) Icebreaker:

Share one thing you want to try or learn this year.

2) Intro Question:

Have you ever wanted a brand-new start? Why?

3) Bible Application:

The Bible teaches that when we trust in Jesus, He forgives our sins and makes us new on the inside. Our past doesn't define us—Jesus does.

4) Leader Thought:

Explain what it means to be “in Christ” and how Jesus changes our hearts, not just our behavior.



THEME:

GOD LOVED FIRST

Verse:

"We love because he first loved us."
— 1 John 4:19 (CSB)



GOD LOVED FIRST



1) Icebreaker:

Name someone who loves you.

2) Intro Question:

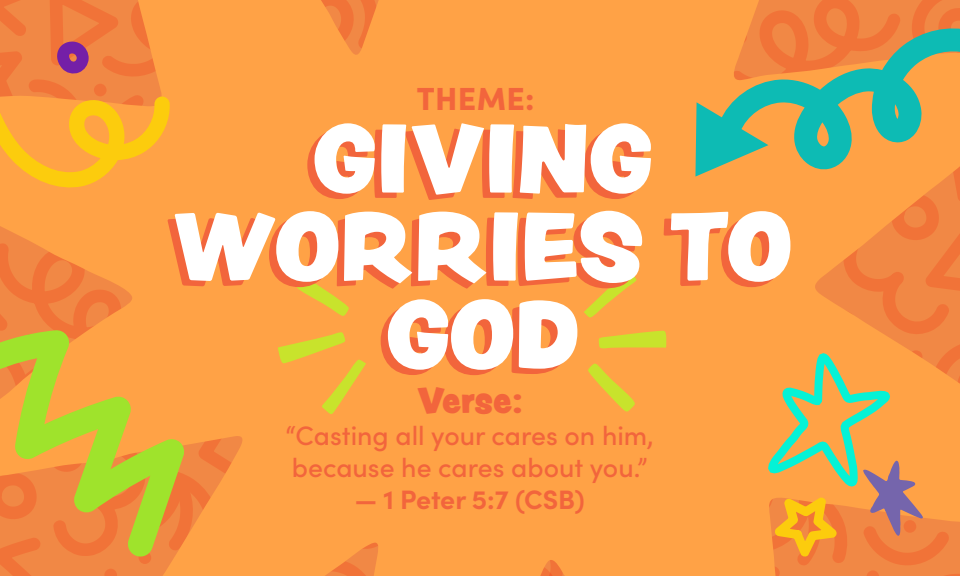
Who loved you before you were even born?

3) Bible Application:

God loved us first. He showed His love by sending Jesus to save us, even when we didn't deserve it.

4) Leader Thought:

Reinforce that God's love comes before anything we do.

THEME:

GIVING WORRIES TO GOD

Verse:

"Casting all your cares on him,

1) Icebreaker:

What's something that makes you feel worried?

2) Intro Question:

Who do you talk to when you are worried?

3) Bible Application:

God cares about everything in our lives. We can trust Him with our worries because He loves us.

4) Leader Thought:

Share about a time when you gave your worries to God.

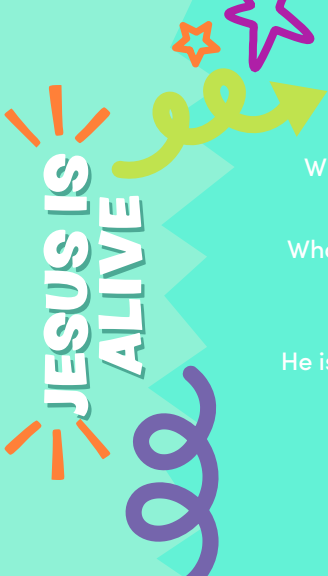


THEME:

Verse:

"He is not here, but he has risen!"
— Luke 24:6 (CSB)



JESUS IS ALIVE



1) Icebreaker:

What's the best surprise you've ever had?

2) Intro Question:

What happened three days after Jesus died?

3) Bible Application:

Jesus rose from the dead. Because He is alive, we have hope and new life in Him.

4) Leader Thought:

Explain how the resurrection of Jesus changed your life.



THEME:

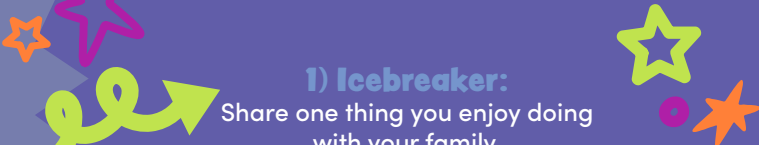
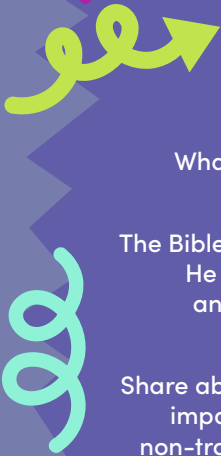
GOD'S GIFT OF FAMILY

Verse:

"Children are a gift from the LORD."
— Psalm 127:3 (NLT)



GOD'S GIFT OF FAMILY



1) Icebreaker:

Share one thing you enjoy doing with your family.

2) Intro Question:

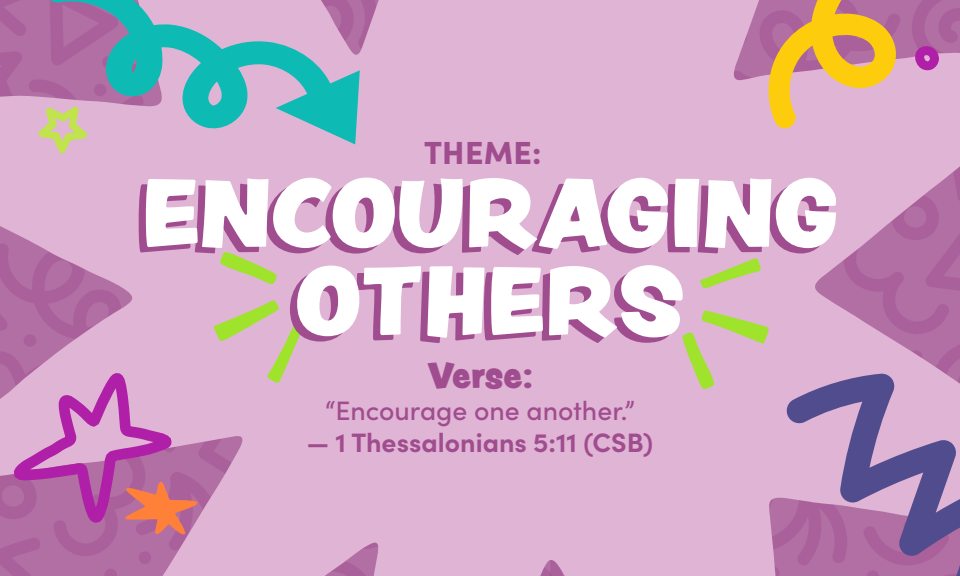
What is one way your family shows love?

3) Bible Application:

The Bible tells us that families are a gift from God. He places us in families to care for one another and to grow together in love.

4) Leader Thought:

Share about your family and others who made an impact on your life (include adoptive and non-traditional families into the conversation).



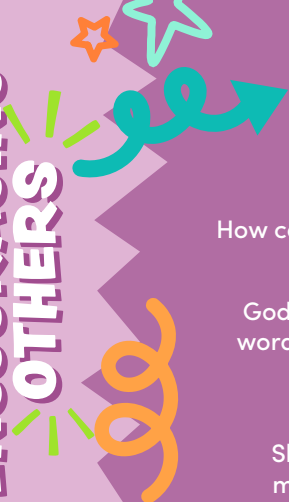
THEME:

Verse:

“Encourage one another.”
— 1 Thessalonians 5:11 (CSB)

ENCOURAGING OTHERS



1) Icebreaker:

Say something kind to the person next to you.

2) Intro Question:

How can you encourage someone this week?

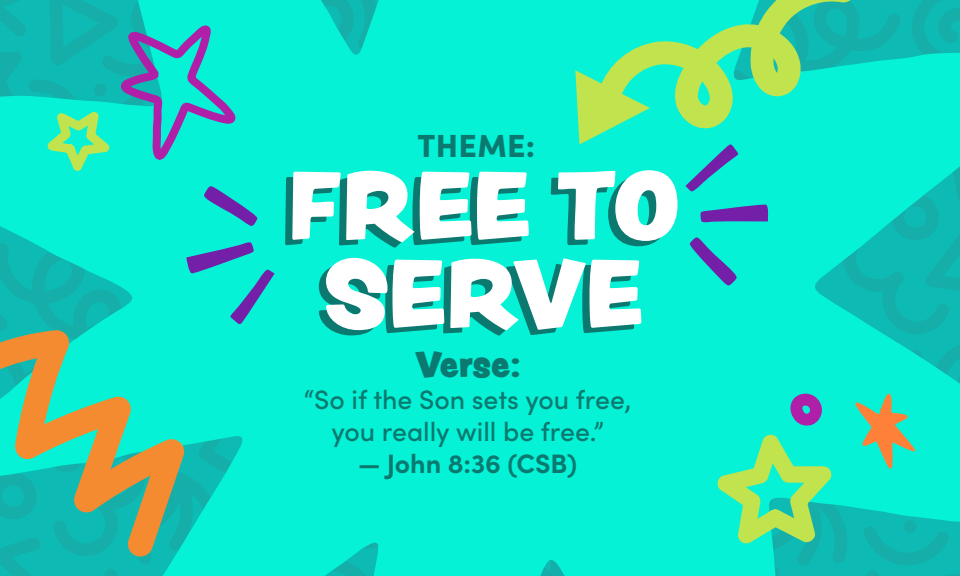
3) Bible Application:

God wants us to build others up with our words and actions. Encouragement helps friends grow and feel loved.

4) Leader Thought:

Share a few ways a friend or family member regularly encourages you.





THEME:

FREE TO SERVE

Verse:

“So if the Son sets you free,
you really will be free.”

— John 8:36 (CSB)

Why does freedom lead us to serve God?

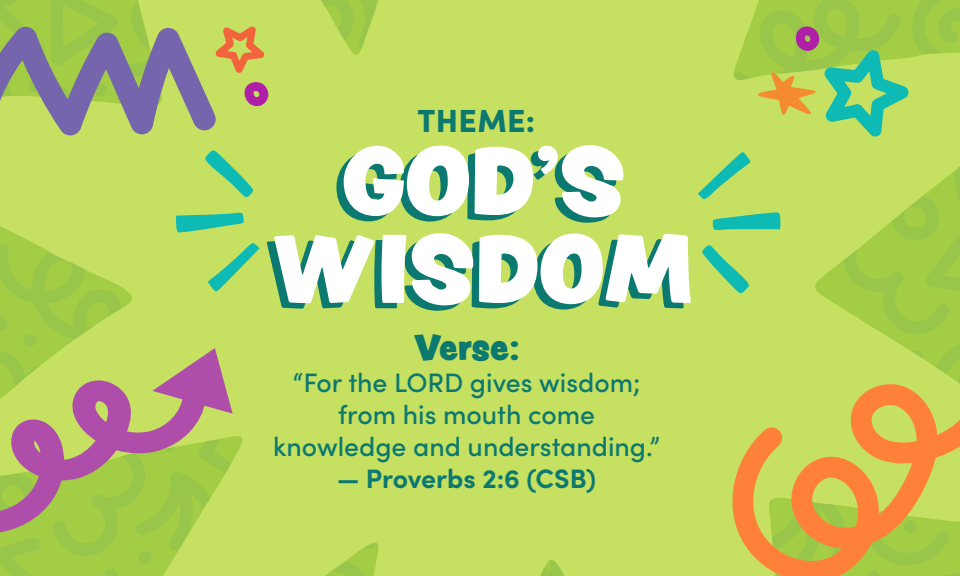
3) Bible Application:

THEME:

GOD'S WISDOM

Verse:

"For the LORD gives wisdom;
from his mouth come
knowledge and understanding."
— Proverbs 2:6 (CSB)



GOD'S WISDOM



1) Icebreaker:

Who do you go to when you need help?

2) Intro Question:

Where does wisdom come from?

3) Bible Application:

True wisdom comes from God. When we trust Him, He helps us make good choices.

4) Leader Thought:

Encourage prayer before decisions.
Preschool Prompt: Pray for teachers.



THEME:

USING OUR GIFTS

Verse:

"Just as each one has received a gift,
use it to serve others."
— 1 Peter 4:10 (CSB)



USING OUR GIFTS



1) Icebreaker:

What's something you're good at?

2) Intro Question:

What gifts can you use for God?

3) Bible Application:

God gives each of us gifts to help others and serve His church.

4) Leader Thought:

Affirm every child has value and purpose.

Preschool Prompt: Practice sharing.





THEME:

GOD IS GREATER

Verse:

"The LORD is my light and my
salvation—whom should I fear?"
— Psalm 27:1 (CSB)



GOD IS GREATER



1) Icebreaker:

What's something that you've always been afraid of?

2) Intro Question:

Why is God bigger than fear?

3) Bible Application:

God is powerful and good. Because He is with us, we don't have to be afraid.

4) Leader Thought:

Shift focus from fear to confidence in God.

Preschool Prompt: God is with me!



THEME:

PRAISE THE LORD

Verse:

"I will praise the Lord all my life."
—Psalm 146:2A (NIV)

PRAISE THE LORD



1) Icebreaker:

What's something good
God has done?

2) Intro Question:

How does thankfulness change your heart?

3) Bible Application:

Thanking God helps us remember His
goodness and grows our joy.

4) Leader Thought:

Share your top three highlights from the week.
Encourage kids to think of theirs too!

Preschool Prompt: Make a thank-you list.





THEME:

GOD IS WITH US

Verse:

"They will name him Immanuel."
— Matthew 1:23 (CSB)
