

# Noah's Ark Craft

## Supplies:

- 2 paper plates per child
- paint
- paintbrushes
- animal shapes (print and cut these out ahead of time)
- markers, crayons, or colored pencils

## Instructions:

1. Cut one paper plate in half—this will be the ark. Instruct kids to paint both sides of the half plate brown.
2. Have kids paint a rainbow on the top of the other plate (the one you did not cut). Make sure the rainbow covers at least 3/4 of the top of the plate.
3. While the paint is drying, provide two of each animal to each child (or allow them to pick which animals they want to use!). Allow them to color in the animals.
4. Once your plates have dried, staple the brown half plate onto the bottom of the full rainbow plate. You've now created the ark!
5. After you staple the plates together, allow kids to put their animals into the ark. Remind them of the Bible story as they are doing this!
